#### **OFSTED** inspection

As you are aware, we have completed our OFSTED inspection on Wednesday and Thursday this week and would like to thank our staff, children and Governors for their contribution to the inspection. As always we are extremely proud of the children and the way they have continued to represent the school positively. Children confidently shared their work, reflections regarding their learning and engaged with inspectors in class, small groups, at break/lunchtimes and at Clubhouse. We will share the report as soon as we are able to following the OFSTED report timings and quality assurance procedure. As you can appreciate, we cannot share any information with you prior to receiving the final report.

## OFSTED Inspecting school guidance-After the inspection visit

The lead inspector will write a report setting out the inspection findings.

We send the draft report to the school, usually within 18 working days of the end of the inspection. The school has 5 working days to comment on the draft report, inspection process and findings.

Typically, we will send the school an electronic version of the final report within 30 working days of the end of the inspection. In most circumstances, we will publish the final report on the <u>Ofsted reports website</u> within 38 working days of the end of the inspection.

We send a copy of the report to:

- the school's headteacher
- the local authority
- the appropriate authority or proprietor (for example, the governing body or the academy trust where the local authority is not the appropriate authority)
- the person or body responsible for appointing foundation governors if the school
  has them (including diocesan or other appropriate authorities in the case of
  schools with a religious character)

 other prescribed persons such as the Department for Education or the Education and Skills Funding Agency

The school must also supply a copy of the report to all parents of registered pupils at the school.
