School Uniform

Can we please remind you that all children should be coming to school in the correct school uniform:

- White or blue polo shirt
- Navy sweatshirt, cardigan or fleece
- Grey or black trousers, shorts, skirt or pinafore.
- Sensible plain black or navy shoes
- White or grey socks or navy or black tights.

For health and safety all children with shoulder length hair should have it tied back for school using blue or black bobbles. Extreme hairstyles such as Mohawks and patterned or brightly coloured hair are not acceptable. All hair wear should be plain and based on school colours. No nail varnish or jewellery should be worn.

Parking reminders

Following an incident reported by one of our neighbours, we are writing to remind all our families of some small measures to consider to ensure the safety of all people in and around the vicinity of our school.

- 1. Please do not park across driveways, entrances/exits or on zig zag areas.
- 2. During peak times of dropping off and picking up children, please follow the 'one way system' coming to school via Dee Road and leaving via School Lane.
- 3. Where possible please use the Hoole Lawn Tennis Club car park and enter/exit school via the Tennis Court Gate.


MMR

Please see the message below from Public Health Programme Lead, Cheshire West and Chester Council.

Due to an increase in measles cases across the country this year, including a recent outbreak in the West Midlands, we are encouraging everyone to check that they and their children have had 2 doses of the MMR vaccine. The MMR vaccine is a free, safe and effective way to protect against measles, mumps and rubella. We need you to help spread this message throughout your early years/education community to help increase vaccine uptake as measles can have serious and sometimes fatal consequences.
