Parents

We will show **We care, We learn, We belong** by:

- Informing school of our child's absence before registers close at 9.10am
- Letting school know as soon as possible if our child shows symptoms of COVID-19,
- Collecting our child from school immediately if they show symptoms of COVID-19 at school and ensure school has up to date emergency contacts details
- Adhering to any changes to Covid 19 measures in place including following social distancing routes when dropping our child off and collecting them
- Ensuring our child attends school regularly, on time and does not bring any non-essential items into school with them
- Explaining any new Covid restrictions implemented and work with school to ensure our child's behaviour does not put anyone else at risk
- Reinforcing the need for good respiratory and hand hygiene with our child
- Approaching school as early as possible with any concerns
- Liaising with school when necessary via telephone or email and ensuring that these discussions are positive, respectful and meaningful
- Supporting schools policies and guidelines to create an 'as safe as possible' environment
- Reading all letters/messages/emails that are sent home
- Supporting our child in homework and other opportunities for home learning (including remote learning) monitoring our child's access to the school learning platform reinforcing the message that contributions should always be non-offensive in any messaging in or out of school.
- Contributing to our child's life at school by engaging with correspondence relating to our child's progress and other relevant information e.g. SAT's, phonics, home learning and subject specific
