I am pleased to tell you that we have provisionally booked for Y5 & Y6 to go on a residential this year for 2 nights Monday 7th March – Wednesday 9th March. It is so lovely to finally get back to some normality.

This year we have compared a number of residential providers and have chosen to take Y5 & Y6 to PGL Boreatton Shropshire https://www.pgl.co.uk/en-gb/school-trips/primary-schools/centres/boreatton-park.

Residentials provide rewarding educational opportunities offering many National Curriculum-linked activities combined with thrilling outdoor and indoor adventure activities. Children benefit hugely from the experience, both educationally and socially and we feel certain that Boreatton Park will prove to be both enjoyable and very worthwhile. As in previous years, we expect that all children will participate in this valuable and rewarding residential experience. One of the great benefits of these trips is the quality of the relationships that develop between the children and their teachers. MTVS Behaviour Policy

We believe in constant praise, positive reinforcement and working together collaboratively in order to achieve the calm, happy learning environment that we are so proud of. We closely follow the inspiring behaviour work and ethos of Paul Dix. Our children are treated with respect, are not shouted at or reprimanded in public and are recognised for going above and beyond. In recognition of children's exemplary behaviour, we have introduced Behaviour Ambassadors. Two children

from Y3 – Y6 who have shown positive behaviour choices have been chosen to act as positive role models for other children. Their specific roles include

- To look out for and support children who are sad and lonely.
- To role model exemplary behaviour.
- To suggest games and ideas for children on the playground.
- To recognise good behaviour around school, e.g. they will be invited to support in the lunch hall one day a week to model good behaviour.
- They will be invited to a termly meeting to feedback pupil voice and any concerns to be actioned regarding behaviour within school
- They will be invited to speak to other stakeholders including visitors and governors

These behaviour ambassadors will change termly.

Christmas Performances

As you are aware we have been extremely lucky and have booked The Storyhouse, Chester, this year for Reception & Y6 children and Year 1 & Year 2 children to perform their Christmas shows. This is a fantastic experience for the children and a magical one for you as parents to watch. Both shows will be on Thursday 16th December 2021. We have hired The Garret Theatre for the day. Reception and Year 6 will perform 'The Big Little Nativity'. Please be in your seats for the show to start promptly at 10.30am. The performance will last approximately 45 minutes. Children will return to school afterwards on the coach we have hired, just in time for lunch.



Year 1 and Year 2 will perform 'The Angel Express'. Please be in your seats and ready for the show to start promptly at 1pm. The performance will last approximately 45 minutes. Children are permitted to go home with you after the show directly from The Storyhouse if you wish.

If you do not wish to collect your child from the Storyhouse, please email the school office on admin@mickletrafford.cheshire.sch.uk so we can arrange for them to be returned to school. Children in

Y1 & Y2 will be eating their lunch at The Storyhouse so please choose a sandwich option when pre ordering on Appetite.

DVDs of the performance can be purchased via scopay by pressing 'products' and selecting the correct title. Please **make your purchase by Monday 13th December.**

We have arranged for the DVD to be produced overnight so they can be sent home with your child on 17th December, which is the last day of term. Because of the short time, only **those which have been purchased in advance** can be produced.

Tickets will cost £1.50 each and we are allocating 2 per child. Tickets should be purchased via scopay by pressing 'products' and selecting the tickets for the correct play. Please make your purchase by Monday 29th November so we can work out how many surplus tickets to offer. If you would like to be considered for more tickets, please email the school office to request a maximum of 2 additional tickets. Names will be drawn out of a hat on 1st December 2021.
