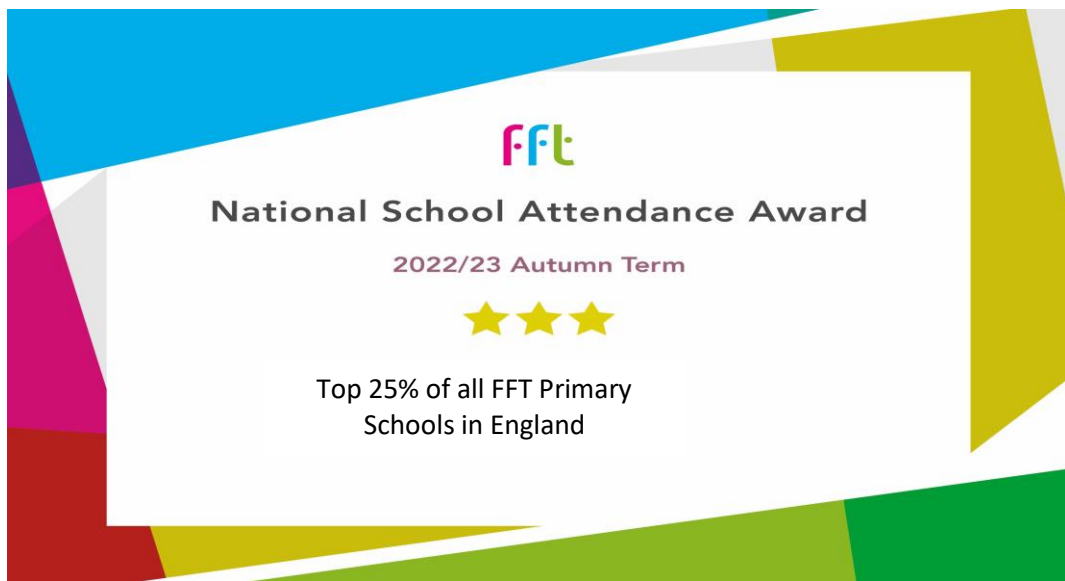




Well that was a very cold week. Can we please say a big thank you to all the children their behaviour throughout the week has been great.
